#### **Workshop on “Good Clinical Practice”**

Department of Pharmacology, BMCH organized a **workshop on “Good Clinical Practice”** on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021 for all faculty members, research scholars and members of the Institutional Ethics Committee. Good clinical practice provides a framework of principles which aim to ensure the safety of research participants and the integrity and validity of data. This workshop aimed to provide the researcher with the basic principles of GCP and how these principles can be applied practically in the research setting. The workshop started with welcome address by Dr. P. Elango, Organizing Secretary, department of Pharmacology, inaugurated by Dr. Edwin Joe, Dean, BMCH and felicitated by Dr. J. Mohana Sundaram, Vice Principal and Organising Chairman, and by Dr. S. Somasundaram, Medical Superintendent, BMCH. Dr P. Elango introduced honorable speaker Dr. Annabelle Rajaseharan, Director – Medical research, The Vinayaka Mission’s research foundation.

It was followed by scientific session started with pre-test. 65 delegates participated in the workshop. All the delegates were taught about the importance of Good clinical Practice in conducting clinical research with practical examples followed by panel discussion participated by Dr J. Mohanasundaram, Dr Annabelle Rajaseharan and Dr N. S. Muthiah, Chair Person, BIEC. The delegates were asked to write post-test and to fill feedback form.
