The Managing Trustee, Sri Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai has applied for establishment of a Medical College at Agaram, Selaiyur, Chennai. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu have decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a new Medical College in the name and style as **“Bhaarath Medical College and Hospital”**, with an annual intake of 150 seats subject to the following conditions:-

- Before MCI inspection the Trust should get plan approval for buildings from CMDA and to complete all the construction work mandatory if any under progress.
- Building completion certificate for these buildings should be obtained from the appropriate authority.
- Building stability certificate for these buildings should be obtained from the appropriate authority, since the buildings have been constructed during the year 2014.
- A separate Blood Bank should be started with fully qualified Medical Officers and Technicians and a License should also be obtained from the concerned authorities before MCI inspection.
- The fire safety license should be obtained before MCI inspection.
- The trust should produce mandatory certificates (viz., AERB approval) before the MCI inspection without-fail.
- The trust should abide MCI norms updated from time to time without any lapse.
- The Trust ensures the undertaking given by them to rectify the deficiencies pointed out by the Government before the MCI inspection without-fail.
- The trust should ensure the availability of 100% faculties, clinical and non clinical materials before the MCI inspection without-fail.

Further bank guarantees specified by Medical Council of India for the establishment of teaching hospital to be handed over to the Medical Council of India, New Delhi and stability certificate of the hospital building obtained from the competent authority should be submitted to the Medical Council of India while making inspection and also rectification of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection Officers before the Medical Council of India inspection and the approval of Medical Council of India/Government of India should be obtained.

It is certified that:-


- a. The applicant owns and manages a 300 Bedded functional Hospital which was established in the campus of the proposed location.
- b. It is desirable and feasible to establish a Medical College in the Public interest
- c. Establishment of a medical college at Agaram, Selaiyur, Chennai by Sri Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai is feasible.
- d. Adequate Clinical Material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical College as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government, if the conditions put forth above is fulfilled by the Trust.

The following shall be added in terms of Notification dated 31.01.2017 published in the Gazette of India :-

- e. The Managing Director own and possesses 20 acres of land in (comprising in S.No. 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, 309, 310, 314, 315 and 383) Agaram, Selaiyur, Chennai on which non-agricultural use of land is permitted and a Medical College/ Hospital can be established on it.
